STAVROS NIARCHOS FOUNDATION

As previously announced, St. Michael's expansion project was awarded a magnanimous grant of \$15,000,000 by the Niarchos Foundation (SNF) for which the Home is eternally grateful. At this time, we share the "good news" that the first installment of \$5,000,000 was received this month enabling the construction work to be dramatically accelerated. To qualify for this payment, we have had to complete 29% of the project (currently it is 31% complete) and secured a construction loan which will be available if needed to complete the construction. According to the grant letter, to receive the second installment of \$5,000,000 (sometime in/after October) construction must be 43% complete (we expect that it will be higher than that by then) and we have collected the overwhelming majority if not all outstanding pledge installments. Moreover, fund-raising efforts must continue to assure the availability of resources so that the project is completed in a timely fashion.



ARCHANGEL MICHAEL MOSAIC

Adorning the façade of the new facility will be a magnificent mosaic icon of the Archangel Michael. Thanks to the magnanimous generosity of the Trustees of the Kallinikeion Foundation, work has commenced on this 12' x 13' mosaic at the studio of Mellini Art Glass & Mosaics in Milan, Italy. We look forward to its installation some time in mid-2023.
