MEET THE TEAM

MANNY KRATSIOS, CHAIR OF THE BUILDING COMMITTEE

Board of Trustee member, Manny P. Kratsios, is currently spearheading the St. Michael's construction project in Uniondale, Long Island. Manny holds a Bachelor of Civil Engineering degree from Columbia University, as well as a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree from St. John's University. He also pursued a Master of Divinity degree at St. Vladimir's Seminary, where he attended classes part-time for three years.

Manny is currently a Managing Director at JLL (Jones Lang LaSalle), the global commercial real estate and construction consulting group in New York City. He oversees hundreds of projects each month, including Up-Front Plan & Cost Reviews, Construction Monitoring and Property Condition Assessments, with budgets in excess of \$35 billion. His projects have ranged across the United States, Canada, Central America, the Caribbean and Europe. Prior to his time at JLL, Manny served as President and CEO of Merritt & Harris, Construction Consultants for more than 32 years, where he managed over 400 world-class facilities throughout the country, including over 30 professional sports venues and many healthcare/nursing home facilities.

The St. Michael's Construction Committee has been working tirelessly for the last five year under his leadership and that of His Grace Bishop Andonios, President Haeda Mihaltses, and the extremely talented group of professionals who comprise the Board of Trustees of the Home. As of January 2020, the final architectural drawings were issued, the bidding process was conducted, which involved

between six to ten trades for each aspect of the project, and a final budget was prepared by the end of the year. In January 2021, construction began following the issuance of the necessary approvals from the New York State Department of Health. Based on all that we know today, it is our hope and prayer that with the generous support of the community, this magnificent state-of-the-art continuum care facility can open its doors by the end of 2022 or the beginning of 2023.
