\$15 MILLION GRANT FROM THE STAVROS NIARCHOS FOUNDATION!

The Board of Trustees of St. Michael's has received official notification that the Stavros Niarchos Foundation (SNF) has awarded the expansion project of the Home a \$15,000,000 grant! The Foundation has a long-standing relationship with St. Michael's and was honored with the Archangel Michael Award by the Home at the annual Name Day in 2006. SNF had offered generous support at that time and assisted the Yonkers facility in enhancing its programing and stabilizing its finances.

Members of the Board have been working closely with SNF team for a number of years regarding the expansion. After extended discussions and an in-depth study and review of all aspects of the project, the Foundation has elected to be a critical part of this undertaking and help bring about its completion.

This award from this internationally acclaimed foundation is a vote of confidence and a validation of what has been envisioned for the new facility and has been taking place at the Uniondale site. In recognition of their generosity the Uniondale site will be known as The Stavros Niarchos Foundation (SNF) Campus. The Home expresses its heartfelt appreciation to the Foundation, especially to its Co-President Mr. Andreas Dracopoulos and his colleagues who worked closely with the members of our team. Beyond the magnanimous and incredibly generous grant, we are especially grateful for their cooperation in realizing this grant, their steadfast belief in the project and the ability of the Board to bring about its realization!

SNF was established in 1996 by Stavros Niarchos and since that time has committed more than \$3.3 billion through over 5,300 grants to non-profit organizations. In 2020 the Foundation announced a \$100 million global initiative to help alleviate the effects of Covid-19 pandemic. Other grantee partners in New York include amongst many others: The New York Public Library, the Child Mind Institute and The Rockefeller University.


PASCHAL APPEAL
